Dates and Times

The conference starts at 08.30 on Saturday 23 February 2013 and finishes at 12.30 on Sunday 24 February 2013 at the National Institute of Education.

The Educational Site Visits are scheduled for the morning of Friday 22 February 2013. Tours will commence at 09:00 and finish after lunch (included) at 13.30. There will be a maximum number of participants on each tour. Pick up and drop off will be at the Hotel Cambodiana.

The Regional ELT Research Forum will be conducted on the morning of Friday 22 February 2013 from 08.30 to 11.30 at the Hotel Cambodiana.

The Conference Dinner will be held on the evening of Saturday 23 February 2013 from 19.30 to 22.00 at the Hotel Cambodiana. Please collect a dinner coupon at the Registration Desk when collecting your name tag and conference materials.

Conference Venue

The conference will be held at the National Institute of Education, Norodom Blvd., corner Street Suramarit, Phnom Penh, Cambodia. A full map of Phnom Penh including the conference venue is available on the CamTESOL website.

Travelling to Phnom Penh

If you are travelling via Phnom Penh International Airport, taxis are available outside the arrivals area. A taxi to

central Phnom Penh costs approximately USD10 and takes about 30mins.

Registration Desk

When you arrive at the venue you will need to come to the registration desk to pick up your name badge, program, and conference bag. Please take good care of these items as we will be unable to replace them if they go missing.

To speed up your registration process at the registration desk, please ensure that you bring a print out of this conference registration confirmation with you.

The registration desk is located in front of the main conference hall at the conference venue. It will be open from 07.30 on Saturday 23 February and 08.00 on Sunday 24 February. It will remain open each day until the very last conference session of the day. Please ensure you leave enough time to register as the desk can get very busy at times.

Conference Bag

The conference bag is provided at the registration desk and contains the conference handbook and lots of useful information and items. Note that there will be over 1500 of these bags in the venue so we suggest you tie something to it so you can easily identify it (i.e. coloured ribbon or a luggage tag).

Conference Program

The draft Conference Program will be mounted on the CamTESOL website on Saturday 16 February. Should there be last-minute changes, these will be announced directly BEFORE the Opening Ceremony. A hard copy program will also be provided at the registration desk.

Dietary Requirements

If you require Vegetarian or Halal food as part of your registration, these meals will be available at clearly marked tables in the lunch serving area at the conference venue. Vegetarian and Halal foods will also be marked at the Conference Dinner.

1. Some abstracts (including titles) may be edited for the program so that they reflect a standardised length and format of presentation
2. If you would like your paper to be considered for the Language Education in Asia publication, we request that you submit an electronic copy of your paper (Microsoft Word or Rich Text Format) to Mr. John Middlecamp, the Assistant Editor-in-Chief of Language Education in Asia at language.education.in.asia@gmail.com. The deadline for paper submission is Friday, 8 March 2013, two weeks after the conference. The guidelines for submissions, including information on referencing, formatting, and suitability are available from the Language Education in Asia webpage at <http://www.camtesol.org/index.php/publication>
3. For both papers and workshops, we request you to leave a designated period of time for questions and audience interaction at the end. You would appreciate that the audience will include many Cambodians who are attending a conference for the first time. Audience interaction will help ensure understanding of your message. Some sessions will have a chairperson, and you can inform the chair of your chosen format before the session, so that the chair can assist you in timing during the session.
4. The theme of the conference is Language and Empowerment. Papers and workshops that reflect this theme and directly address the audience will help ensure the cohesiveness of the conference.
5. Photocopy facilities will NOT be available at the conference venue. A local institution will be hosting this conference. Please bring handouts with you. We recommend a minimum of 50 copies.


Presenters will also be invited to a "Presenters' Warm Up" (Welcome) function
